* Strategic Investment Program (SIP)

The National Pork Producers Council (NPPC) is funded by voluntary contributions from pork producers and allied industry into the Strategic Investment Program (SIP). To be a member of NPPC, pork producers agree to contribute 10 cents per \$100 in value on all pigs marketed during each year into SIP. A minimum annual contribution of \$100 is required. Any TPPA member that contributes to the Strategic Investment Program a minimum of \$100 or the equivalent of 10 cents per \$100 in value for all pigs marketed in a year (which ever is greater) will also receive credit for having paid their TPPA annual membership fees. You may include your SIP contribution in your check and we will register you as a member of both TPPA & NPPC.
